	A guide to actions that lead to consequences	Consequences/Interventions
<b>L E V E L 1</b>	Failing to respect the College Expectations including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chewing gum or eating food inappropriately (on oval and/or classroom).</li> <li>• Disrupting a class.</li> <li>• Disrespecting College/personal equipment/property.</li> <li>• Inappropriate language/gestures.</li> <li>• Incorrect wearing of uniform/jewellery without a note.</li> <li>• Late to class without a pass x 3 (per term).</li> <li>• Underprepared for class x 3 (per term) e.g. lack of equipment, flat battery, etc.).</li> <li>• Homework incomplete x 3 (per term).</li> <li>• Inappropriate contact between students.</li> <li>• ICT Minor Issue.</li> </ul>	Teacher Directed options: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teacher warning and consequences.</li> <li>• Communication with Parents/ Care Giver where appropriate.</li> <li>• Working Room.</li> <li>• Incorrect uniform without a note – parent notified for their child to comply to the wearing of the correct uniform by Roll Teacher.</li> </ul>
<b>L E V E L 2</b>	If a student is on Level 1 and continues to demonstrate the behaviour within one school week <b>OR</b> at the discretion of the Behaviour Management Team <b>OR</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Low level forms of bullying.</li> <li>• Littering.</li> <li>• Being out of bounds.</li> <li>• Poor Sportsmanship.</li> <li>• Using mobile phone or similar electronic device during College hours.</li> </ul>	Teacher to notify parent of incident.  Possible consequences and support at this level: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meeting with Behaviour Management Representative to discuss and implement consequences.</li> <li>• Behaviour Card.</li> <li>• Community service (e.g. picking up rubbish).</li> <li>• Appointment with Chaplain and/or Counsellor where needed.</li> </ul>
<b>L E V E L 3</b>	If a student is on Level 2 and continues to demonstrate the behaviour within one school week <b>OR</b> at the discretion of the Behaviour Management Team <b>OR</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deliberate damage to College equipment.</li> <li>• Dishonesty with intent to mislead or cause harm.</li> <li>• Disobedience/Disrespect to staff.</li> <li>• Behaviours that put themselves or others in harms way.</li> <li>• Leaving the school grounds without parental and administrative permission.</li> <li>• Engaging in bullying of any kind (verbal, digital or written) or using objectionable language in public or private messages is prohibited.</li> <li>• Sending of mass emails, chain letters and/or spam that are harmful or damaging.</li> </ul>	Process: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Withdrawn from class.</li> <li>• Student interview with Secondary Coordinator.</li> <li>• Meeting with Behaviour Management representative to discuss and implement consequences and parent notified.</li> <li>• Secondary Coordinator meets with Behaviour Management Team to discuss strategies and consequences moving forward.</li> <li>• Written communication with parents outlining outcomes and consequences.</li> </ul> Possible consequences and support at this level: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May be withdrawn from classes/working to improve College grounds with parental permission.</li> <li>• Behaviour card where appropriate.</li> <li>• Appointment with Chaplain and/or Counsellor where needed.</li> <li>• Suspension.</li> <li>• While on Level 3 students are denied the privilege of attending camps, optional excursions, playing on representative sport teams, or attending College social activities.</li> </ul> Students remain at this level for a minimum of two weeks.

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<b>L E V E L 4</b>	If a student is on Level 3 and continues to demonstrate the behaviour within one school week <b>OR</b> at the discretion of the Behaviour Management Team <b>OR</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Driving or being driven in a vehicle without parental and administrative permission.</li> <li>• Possession of obscene or objectionable materials.</li> <li>• Deliberate deletion or installing of program or system files.</li> <li>• Gross poor sportsmanship.</li> <li>• Stealing.</li> <li>• Deliberate vandalism.</li> <li>• Physical violence.</li> </ul>	Process: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Withdrawn from class.</li> <li>• Student interview with Secondary Coordinator.</li> <li>• Meeting with Behaviour Management representative to discuss and implement consequences moving forward and parent notified.</li> <li>• Written communication with parents outlining outcomes and consequences.</li> </ul> Possible consequences and support at this level: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Suspension (between 2-3 days).</li> <li>• Behaviour card where appropriate on re-entry to classes.</li> <li>• Appointment with Chaplain and/or Counsellor where needed.</li> <li>• While on Level 4 students are denied the privilege of attending camps, optional excursions, playing on representative sport teams or attending College social activities.</li> </ul> Students remain at this level for a minimum of three weeks.
<b>L E V E L 5</b>	If a student is on Level 4 and continues to demonstrate the behaviour within one school week <b>OR</b> at the discretion of the Behaviour Management Team <b>OR</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Gross disrespect of a staff member.</li> <li>• Serious and deliberate vandalism.</li> <li>• Severe harassment or bullying.</li> <li>• Physical violence resulting in serious injury.</li> <li>• Possession of a weapon with intent to cause harm.</li> <li>• Use of mobile phone or other electronic devices to communicate obscene or objectionable material.</li> <li>• Sending, accessing, uploading, downloading, or distributing offensive, profane, threatening, violent, pornographic, obscene, illegal or sexually explicit materials is prohibited.</li> <li>• Attempting to repair, remove or install hardware components on school devices.</li> <li>• Inappropriate media and software, defined at the discretion of the administration, may not be used. Inappropriate material may include, but it is not limited to: weapons, pornographic materials, violence, alcohol, drug and gang related symbols or pictures.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School Administration and Behaviour Management Team to review incident and previous behavior history.</li> <li>• Consequences at this level may include: multi day suspension (up to 10 days) or termination of enrolment.</li> <li>• Parent interview with the Principal and Secondary Coordinator to review behaviour history and finalise consequences.</li> <li>• The College reserves the right to involve the Police if necessary.</li> </ul>
<b>L V L 6</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Being in possession of cigarettes or smoking on school grounds or vehicles.</li> <li>• Illicit drugs or alcohol.</li> <li>• Arson on/around College property.</li> <li>• Any drug related device or items, e.g. e-cigarettes, vaping/devices.</li> </ul>	Enrolment Terminated.
