Student Leader Application Form 2024

Thank you for your interest in applying for a leadership position at Noosa Christian College.

The following information is relevant to the roles you can apply for and the expectations that go with them.

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Expectations for student leaders:

To be a student leader, you need to demonstrate the following:

- Be a responsible role model at all times.
- Wear the uniform correctly.
- Follow school rules and encourage others to do the same.
- Represent the school in public and at school events.
- Attend, participate, and assist in all sporting carnivals – swimming, cross country, athletics.
- Attend community events e.g. - ANZAC Day, Day for Daniel.
- Represent the student body.
- Provide a report for the school magazine.
- Be a member of the SRC and attend the meetings.
- Speaking publicly at events and assemblies.
- Be present at awards ceremonies and special days e.g. - ANZAC Day, NAIDOC Ceremony.
- Organise and run at least two student-focused events each term.
- Liaise with Sports Coordinators/teachers and administration for announcements for assemblies.
- Enthuse and lead students in the sign-up for and attendance of whole school events and activities. This may require attending other homerooms to advertise and obtain sign-ups for events.
- Nominate awards for students who demonstrate school values.

Failure to demonstrate responsible behaviour and positive leadership will result in a review by the administration of the leadership position and possible removal.

Application process:

1. Written application/or nomination by a teacher.
2. At least one referee.
3. Interview with Administration staff.
4. Speech delivered to student body.

You may wish to consider:

- What role you wish to apply for.
- What we can expect to see from you in this role.
- What ideas you have moving forward that will benefit the school/students.
- What expectations you have for teachers/staff to support you. How have you displayed leadership in the past? (chaplaincy, organisation of events, behaviours, role-modelling, service, etc.).
- Who would be a good referee for you? (pastor, teacher, employer, coach etc.).
- Any other relevant information that may assist your application.

Timeline for application process:

- Applications open Tuesday, 4th October.
- Applications close Monday, 18th October.
- Selection Panel to meet and go through applications – Wednesday, 26th October. (Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed).
- Interviews conducted 19th - 27th October. Students will be provided with a rating for their interview.
- Present speeches to the whole school assembly.
- Voting by student body.
- 2024 Captains announced at awards presentation night.
